Notes/Comments:

All courses must have grades of "C" or higher to be eligible for transfer.

- (1) Only required for First Time in College (FTIC) students
- (2) Choose from ARTS 1301, ARTS 1303, ARTS 1304, DRAM 1310 or MUSI 1306
- (3) Choose 2 sequential courses in the **same** foreign language depending on fluency (Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Spanish, Italian, Japanese, Portuguese or Spanish). Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) by external challenge exams include CLEP (Written and ACTFL Oral are both required for UST), AP (taken in high school) or IB (taken in high school). Students and Native Speakers can receive transfer credit for lower level foreign language course(s) at LSC based on score earned on exam. <http://www.lonestar.edu/exam-credit.htm> AP and IB credit may not apply toward a minor in a Foreign Language at UST. IB credit may not be used as a prerequisite for upper division courses in the discipline.
- (4) Satisfies International Studies Area of Concentration (AOC) requirement
- (5) Choose three additional International Studies (IS) courses. Section chosen must be specifically designated as International Studies (IS).

Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Application fees will be **waived** for LSC students and employees
- Courses with a grade lower than a “C” (2.0 GPA) are not accepted for transfer; a maximum of 72 hours from a two-year institution can be applied toward a degree from UST
- Recognize the eligibility of LSC students and employees to apply for available Scholarship Programs:
 - **Monaghan Transfer Scholarship:** completed at least 16 hours of transferrable college credit, cumulative GPA of 3.0 from U.S. institution (cumulative GPA based on college level credit from all schools attended) and enrolled full time; students who apply to UST and accepted by July 15 will be guaranteed the scholarship and they are eligible to receive:
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.5 and higher - \$12,000/year
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 to 3.49 - \$10,000/year
 - Phi Theta Kappa Members - \$5,000/year
 - **Transfer Celt Award**
 - Cumulative GPA of 2.5 to 2.99
Are eligible to receive \$5,000/year

Optional Partnership

- Joint Admissions
 - Students jointly admitted to LSC and UST will receive:
 - Student ID, computer/internet account, access to computer labs and access to libraries at LSC and UST
 - Student access to sporting events at UST
 - Free electronic transfer transcript transmission/evaluation
- Cooperative Advising
 - Students can access academic advisors at LSC and UST for the purpose of planning and selecting courses applicable to the anticipated program at both institutions. Opportunity applies to:
 - All LSC students with an expressed interest in transferring to UST and applies to advising for all degree programs (including undecided) at UST
