**Notes/Comments (AA Criminal Justice FOS to BA in Criminal Justice at SFA):**

- (1) BA in Criminal Justice requires 2 years (4 semesters; 1311/1411, 1312/1412, 2311, and 2312) of the same foreign language. Ask an advisor about AP, CLEP or AVANT test to receive credit or placement into higher levels of foreign language through [PLA](#). If intermediate level placement is achieved with AVANT, student must earn a "C" or better in this class to receive credit at SFA for prior courses in sequence. (SFA also offers SPA 242 – Spanish for Heritage Speakers and LSC offers SPAN 2313 and SPAN 2315 – Spanish for Native Speakers I & II)
- (2) SFA will accept Foreign Language 2311 or 2312 (or SPAN 2313/SPAN 2315) to satisfy the Lang./Phil./Culture Core Component Area. SFA also requires an additional Lang./Phil./Culture class with a different prefix from the one used in core. (ex: If Foreign Language 2311 or 2312 satisfies Lang./Phil./Culture Core Component Area, student must choose 1 additional ENGL, PHIL or HUMA class listed in Lang./Phil./Culture Core Component Area.)
- (3) Student must complete 42 advanced hours (at least 36 at SFA). Advanced = 300-400 level
- (4) For this Program to Program Articulation Agreement with SFA only, student only needs to take PSYC 2301 **OR** SOCI 1301. The Criminal Justice Curriculum Team at LSC has agreed to a case-by-case course substitution (Foreign Language can substitute for one of these classes since SFA does not require both PSYC 2301 and SOCI 1301).
