Core complete indicated on hard copy, not electronic.
- (2) Student must have completed MATH 0309, MATH 0310 or college level math course with a minimum grade of "C" or achieve placement into college level math through an assessment test prior to applying to LSC Nursing Program. UT Tyler requires student to complete MATH 1342-Statistics.
- (3) General education elective of at least 3 hours needed if student is not First Time in College (FTIC) and does not take EDUC 1300.
- (4) NURS 3415 can be taken while waiting for NCLEX results.

Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Grades of “D” in core curriculum courses will not be accepted unless the transfer student is core complete.
- Reverse transfer of credit from UT Tyler to LSC allows students to complete requirements for the associate degree prior to completion of bachelor’s degree.
- Application fees will be waived for LSC students and employees.
- Students are eligible to apply for New Transfer scholarship program. For more eligibility information, visit:

*Please note, scholarships may not be applicable to all UT Tyler programs based on minimum credit hours required each semester.
- LSC Honors students admitted to UT Tyler will receive:
 - Acceptance to UT Tyler Honors College with a minimum GPA of 3.5 and satisfaction of other Honors College admission criteria such as, participation in Honors at College: pending funding
 - UT Tyler will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credits
 - Honors students may be eligible for additional scholarships
 - If space permits, Honors students will be eligible to live in UT Tyler Honors housing

Optional Partnership

- Students jointly admitted to LSC and UT Tyler will receive:
 - Student ID at LSC and UT Tyler
 - Student computer/internet account at LSC and UT Tyler
 - Student access to computer labs and libraries at LSC and UT Tyler
 - Student access to sporting events at UT Tyler
 - Free electronic transfer transcript transmission/evaluation
- LSC students and employees admitted to UT Tyler will be allowed access to academic advising services at UT Tyler.

**(Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (Block) to
Bachelor of Science in Nursing - RN to BSN)**

Program Admission Requirements

- Admission to the RN-BSN track is every academic semester (fall, spring, summer).

Program Specific Requirements

- College graduates who have obtained the RN license will automatically have their LSC courses accepted en block in transfer.
- Advanced placement credit is awarded for 30 SCH from LSC nursing program upon completion of all requirements.
