- Refer to CORE requirements at LSC (Course suggestions are based on 2016-2017 catalog. If students entered the program under a different catalog year, please ensure you are considered "Core Complete" and this is indicated on your Lone Star College transcript). Core complete is stated on hard copy, not electronic.
- Student must have completed MATH 0309, MATH 0310 or college level math course with a minimum grade of "C" or achieve placement into college level math through an assessment test prior to applying to LSC Nursing Program. If a student is core complete, then SHSU will accept either MATH 1342 OR PSYC 3317.
- Student will need a total of 10 hours of general education electives; CHEM 1405 and BIOL 1322 recommended as 7 of these hours, but not required. General education elective of at least 3 hours needed if student is not First Time in College (FTIC) and does not take EDUC 1300.

- LSC Honors students admitted to SHSU will receive:
 - Acceptance to SHSU Honors College with a minimum GPA of 3.25 and satisfaction of other Honors College admission criteria such as, full-time enrollment of at least 12 hours.
 - SHSU will accept a maximum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credits
 - Honors students may be eligible for additional scholarships
 - If space permits, Honors students will be eligible to live in SHSU Honors housing

Optional Partnership

- Students jointly admitted to LSC and SHSU will receive:
 - Student ID at LSC and SHSU
 - Student computer/internet account at LSC and SHSU
 - Student access to computer labs and libraries at LSC and SHSU
 - Student access to sporting events at SHSU
 - Students will receive 3 unofficial transcripts at no cost. There will be a 3rd party fee for an official transcript.
 - LSC will have access to free electronic transcripts from SHSU, upon request from student for transmission of transcript.
- LSC students and employees admitted to SHSU will be allowed access to academic advising services at SHSU.

Program Admission Requirements

UNCONDITIONAL ADMISSION

- Application to SHSU
- Unencumbered Texas RN License (or compact license)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 (out of 4.0) overall and prerequisites
- Compliance with clinical readiness requirements (Immunizations, CPR, liability and health insurance, background check and drug screen)
- Completion of prerequisite course work prior to enrolling in nursing courses

JOINT ADMISSION

- Application to SHSU
- Enrollment in associate degree program and completion of the first semester
- Cumulative GPA of 2.75 and prerequisite GPA of 2.5 (out of 4.0)
- May enroll in NURS 3370 in final semester of associate degree program
- May enroll in NURS 4282 prior to licensure
- Compliance with clinical readiness requirements (Immunizations, CPR, liability and health insurance, background check and drug screen) prior to enrolling in SHSU clinical courses

CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

- Application to SHSU
- Unencumbered Texas RN License (or compact license)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 (out of 4.0) overall and prerequisites
- Compliance with clinical readiness requirements (Immunizations, CPR, liability and health insurance, background check and drug screen)
- Missing no more than four (4) non-nursing courses (pre-requisites and core)
- Incomplete non-nursing courses must be completed within one (1) year of enrollment in RN-BSN courses
- Statistics is a pre-requisite to Research.

Program Specific Requirements

- If student is Core Complete in Life and Physical Sciences Foundational Component Area, SHSU does not require CHEM 1405, however student will need to meet general education elective hour requirements for SHSU (refer to (3) in Notes/Comments section on the Transfer Degree Map).
- BIOL 1322-Nutrition is waived for students who complete the Nursing Specialization (Integrated Curriculum) AAS, however student will need to meet general education elective hour requirements for SHSU (refer to (3) in Notes/Comments section on the Transfer Degree Map).
- Student may take NURS 3370 and NURS 4382 in last semester of LSC ADN program with LSC Nursing Director approval.
