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## Developmental Education Exemptions

Students meeting the following requirements are exempt from TSI, and should be allowed to enroll in **entry-level freshman courses**: (*Title 19, Part 1, Chapter 4, SubChapter C, §Rule 4.54*)

1. A student who tests and performs at or above the following standards:

2. A student who graduated with an associate or baccalaureate degree from an institution of higher education.
3. A student who transfers from a private or independent institution of higher education or an accredited out-of-state institution of higher education and who has satisfactorily completed college-level coursework as determined by LSC.
4. A student who has previously attended any institution and has been determined to have met readiness standards by that institution.
5. A student who is enrolled in a level-one certificate program (42 or fewer credit hours)
6. A student who is serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States, the Texas National Guard, or as a member of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States and has been serving for at least three years preceding enrollment.
7. A student who on or after August 1, 1990, was honorably discharged, retired, or released from active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States or the Texas national Guard or service as a member of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States.
