History, Mission and Area Demographics

Located in the North Houston metro area of Texas, we serve 1,400 square miles in Harris, Montgomery and San Jacinto Counties.

Our tax rate is 10.79 cents per \$100 valuation. The first \$5,000 or 1% of appraised value, whichever is greater, of owned and occupied residential property is exempt. Also exempt: the first \$75,000 of a resident property owned and occupied by a person over 65 years old. Taxes are frozen at 2006 amounts for a person 65 or older or disabled.

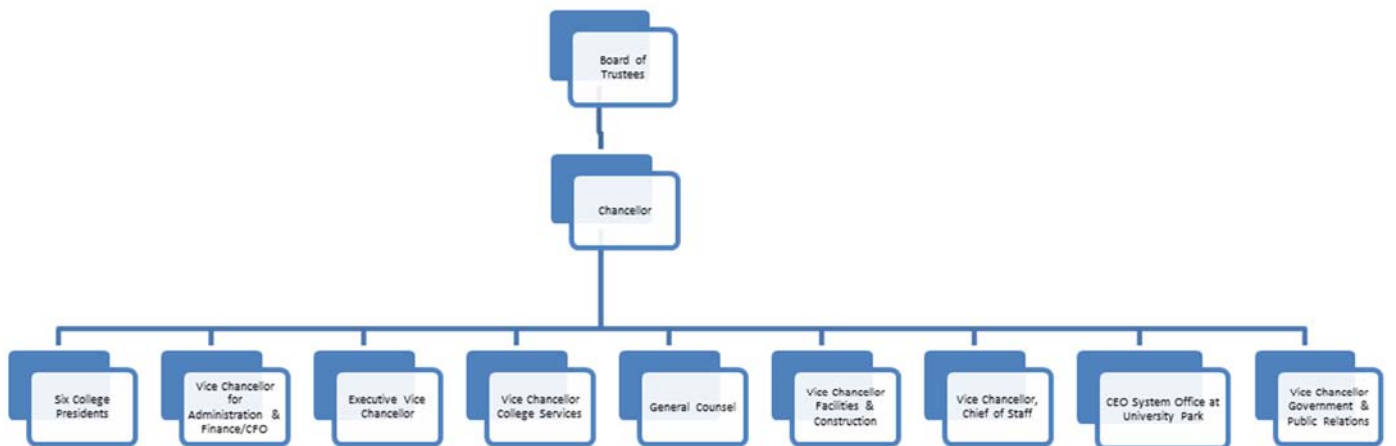
