

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

(CONTINUED)

What should happen if my child becomes ill during your camp?

You will be notified immediately.

What if my child needs to take medications while they are here?

We are not allowed to administer medications. You will need to come to our campus to administer any needed medications.

Where will my child's classroom be located?

We have a short orientation for parents each Monday morning promptly at 8 a.m. and again at 1 p.m. for afternoon sessions. You are welcome to walk with your child to class so that you can see where your child's classroom is located.

How many students are in each class?

Class sizes range from 14 – 20 students.

Are the teachers certified?

Our teachers are either certified or an expert in their field.

Is my child ever left unattended on campus?

Absolutely not!

Since students will be in class for four hours, does each class have breaks?

There will be breaks at the teacher's discretion. There will be more water breaks during outside sessions or classes requiring physical activities.

For the outdoor classes, will my child be outside the whole time, or will they be able to come inside where they are away from the heat?

Your child will not be outside during the full class period. They will also have inside breaks during classes.

Will my child need to bring anything or will supplies be provided?

Supplies are furnished for most of our classes. If a student is required to bring supplies, it will be stated in the course description.

Can my child bring sunblock, bug spray, water bottle, etc.?

Yes. Please label all personal items. Students will have to administer it themselves.

Will curriculum be the same for repeat classes throughout the summer?

Yes. All courses with the same title will have the same curriculum.

If my child is 5 1/2 years old, can they come to camp?

If they turn six before a class begins, they are eligible to attend that session and subsequent sessions.

Do you serve lunch?

For students who are in our program all day, we offer a lunch plan that can be purchased through our cafeteria Monday – Thursday. On Friday, your child will need to bring lunch. If you prefer, your child can bring lunch each day.

What is included in the lunch plan purchased from the school? How much is it?

Every day is a choice of a hot dog or a hot meal. It also includes a choice of milk or juice, and a fruit cup or cookie. The cost is \$2.75 per day. The meal plan must be purchased on Monday morning.

Is my child allowed to use vending machines at the school?

Due to potential allergic reactions, students are not allowed to use the vending machines.

Are cell phones allowed at the camp?

They are allowed as long as they are put away during class.

Are any electric devices permitted while my child attends camp?

Cell phones, iPods and handheld games can be used during lunch. All electronic devices must be put away during class.

Do you offer the same classes as LSC-Fairbanks Center?

Yes, we offer some of the same classes, but others are unique to LSC-Fairbanks Center.

Why is my child's social security needed?

Having your child's social security number helps our registration office cross reference your child in our system.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I know if a course requires additional material fees?

It will be stated in the course description.

Will I receive a receipt or confirmation if I fax my registration?

We do not accept faxed registrations. You must register face-to-face.

Will I be entitled to a refund if I have to cancel my registration?

Yes. Refunds will be provided for any class cancelled at least seven days prior to the start of the class.

How long will my refund take?

Refunds will be processed as a check and mailed to your address on file. Please allow four to six weeks for processing.

Will my child receive a discount if he/she is a returning student?

No. Each course is priced according to the established pricing guidelines.

Do I receive a discount for having more than one child in the program?

No. Each course is priced according to the established pricing guidelines.

Can I set up a payment plan?

No. Payment is due in full at time of registration.

If my child must miss a day of class, will I get a discount?

No. Each course is priced according to the established pricing guidelines.

Where is drop-off/pick-up for students?

It's located on the north side of our campus outside of the College Center. See campus map.

Drop off or pick up during inclement weather—what is the procedure?

To drop off or pick up your child in the event of inclement weather (lightening and/or thundering), you will need to park and walk into the College Center. In case of light rain or showers, we will escort your youth to the cars.

Can I drop my child off before the class starts?

Yes. Drop-off begins 30 minutes prior to class: 7:30 a.m. for the morning session and 12:30 p.m. for the afternoon session.

What should I do if I arrive late for the class session?

Bring your child to the MOD1 Building, room 110 and a staff member will take them to their assigned class.

What are the procedures during pick-up?

Students will be escorted to the Conference Center at 4:45 p.m. Car tags are issued on Monday morning and should be placed on the dashboard. Students are escorted to the appropriate car by a staff member.

What if someone picking up my child does not have a car tag?

They will need to park at the Conference Center and come inside with their driver's license. The individual will be checked to make sure they are on the authorized list for pick-up.

What should I do if I can't make it by 5 p.m. to pick up my child?

Call our Continuing Education office at 281.290.3460 to inform us that you are going to be late. Your child will not be left alone under any circumstances. However, there will be an additional \$5 fee for any pick-up after 12:30 p.m. for morning classes and after 5 p.m. for afternoon classes.

What procedures should I follow if I need to pick up my child early?

You will need to contact the Continuing Education office at 281.290.3460 to inform us that you are going to be early. You can come to the MOD1 building to pick up your child. You or your designated adult will need to show a driver's license to our staff.

What is the restroom procedure?

Students are escorted to restrooms and the restrooms are cleared by a staff member. If a student needs to go to the restroom during class time, these procedures will still be followed.

What if my child forgets their lunch or other items?

If you need to deliver something to your child during class time, bring the item to the MOD1 Continuing Education Office. We will make sure it is delivered to your child.

What should I do if I want to cancel classes?

Cancellations should be requested in writing at least one week prior to the start of class to be eligible for a refund.
