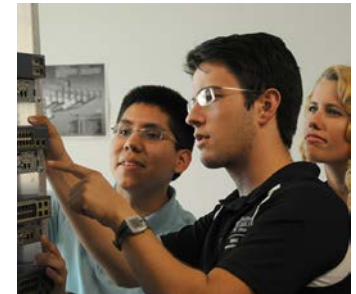

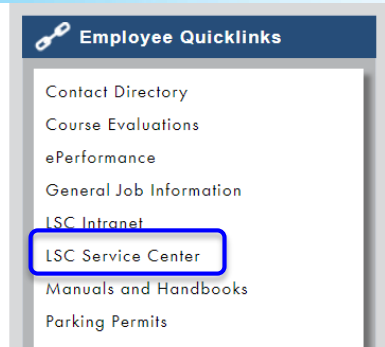




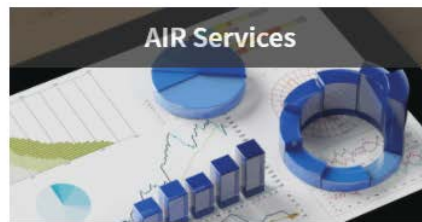
LSC Grant Process

- LSC process based in Policy III.A.2
- The Chancellor is the only one with authority to sign or authorize a grant application on behalf of the college
- All grant applications require written approval by your reporting chain
- You can ask RDA for help by submitting a ticket in Service Now

How to Submit a Service Now Ticket for Assistance With a Grant



1. Log in to myLoneStar
2. Select LSC Service Center from the Employee Quicklinks



3. Select Grants Services
4. Select Grant Requests



Institutional Review Board

- Purpose is to protect all human subjects
- Research involving LSC students or employees needs to be reviewed prior to beginning the research
- Forms and instructions are on the web page
- Review and/or approval is necessary if you are going to include research data in a presentation or publication.



Institutional Review Board

www.lonestar.edu/irb

- LSC IRB does not give permission to conduct research.
 - IRB approves the method by which you perform your research as it relates to human subjects.
 - Permission to conduct research is granted by the Location Executive Officer or LEO
 - LEO for a campus is the President
 - LEO for the system is the Chancellor



Examples of IRB Review Needed

When research includes

- Collection of survey data
- Collection of interview data
- Collection of Focus group data
- Use of student data of any sort
