Participants will hear from experienced litigators about the following oral advocacy ideas:

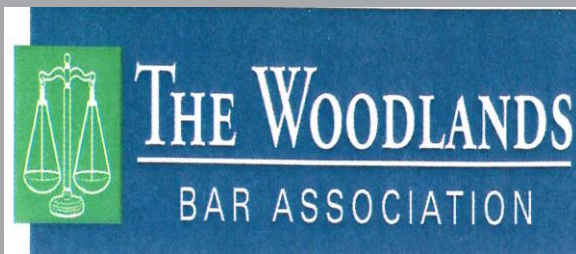
