Examples of Learning Outcomes Recommendations

Below is a categorized list of recommendations based on the 2016-2017 course and program level learning outcomes data. This list can be used as a set of examples for ...

- √ faculty making recommendations for improvement when they submit learning outcome assessment data:
- ✓ disciplines, programs, and curriculum teams when making recommendations to improve their departments and programs.

Examples of Improvement Recommendations by Category		
Change Categories	Examples	
Instructional Changes	 Gave real world examples of how engineers use freehand sketching; Incorporated new interactive learning activities; Engaged students using teamwork activities; Increased the number of critical thinking and problem solving assignments; Invited guest speaker to talk to the graduating class. 	
Curricular Changes	 Adopted a more functional curriculum; Incorporated nursing competencies into clinical and simulation environment; Selected new textbook; Redesigned assignments to support active instruction; Redirected focus on advanced math instead of on basic math. 	
Learner Support	 Faculty met with students to provide one-on-one help; Faculty members mentored students who were at risk of failing; Provided students with videos on study skills; Incorporated time management skills in clinical courses; Implemented Early Alert for all courses. 	
Assessment Changes	 Aligned assessment questions with class assignments; Incorporated more pre and post assessment of information related to learning outcomes; Increased the number of questions for the exam; Presented the assessment rubric to students prior to assessment; Revised assessment instrument. 	
Faculty Prof. Dev.	 Promoted faculty communication between campus and centers to align methods of instructional delivery; Utilized departmental meetings and Adjunct Faculty Orientation to emphasize the importance of learning outcome assessment and continuous improvement; Invited Adjunct Faculty to departmental meetings; Faculty created a repository of teaching and assessment materials to share within the faculty online community group; Faculty met once a week to discuss classroom strategies and share ideas. 	
Others	 Sought input from industry on improving the program; Recognized students' service learning hours on the transcripts; Placed more emphasis on not enrolling at risk students in half an hour class; Used small class size to intensify faculty and student interaction; Moved the class to morning class time.
