

# CONNECT TO THE DISPLAY MONITOR

## Does your laptop have an HDMI or VGA port?



**1** Use the HDMI cable already attached to the wall outlet.

- Do NOT unplug the HDMI cable from the wall outlet or any cables from the monitor.

**2** Plug the free end of the HDMI cable into the matching port on your laptop.



**1** Use a VGA cable like one pictured to the left.

- A limited number of VGA cables are available to borrow at the Reference Desk.
- Mac users may also need a VGA **adapter** (not available from the library).

**2** Plug one end of the VGA cable into the wall outlet, and the other end into the matching port on your laptop.



- Audio requires a separate audio cable.

## Project to the wall monitor.

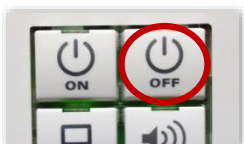
**3**



- ➔ Press the "ON" button on the control panel located on the opposite wall.
- ➔ Wait 5-10 seconds and then select **HDMI** or **VGA**, depending on your connection.

- The display monitor on the wall will show the laptop screen or let you know if the connection is not working.
- Adjust volume as needed, keeping in mind that others are studying in rooms adjacent to yours.

## Before you leave...



Turn off the monitor using the wall switch.

Note: Return all borrowed cables/cords to the 1<sup>st</sup> floor referenced desk, placed in the bag provided, upon your departure from the study room.
