How to Cite Authors and Editors	List multiple authors in the order they are given in the article	In Text Cite
One Author	Gilman, Sandra.	(Gilman)
Two Authors	Gilman, Sandra, and Robert Smith.	(Gilman and Smith)
Three Authors	Gilman, Sandra, Robert Smith, and Ann Jones.	(Gilman, Smith, and Jones)
Four or More Authors	Gilman, Sandra, et al. (<i>et al.</i> means "and others")	(Gilman et al.)
Editor, if author given	Jones, Sandra. <u>Recipes for Today</u> . Ed. Susan Johnson.	(Jones)
Editor, if no author	Johnson, Susan, ed. <u>Recipes for Today</u> .	(Johnson)
Two Editors	Jones, Susan, and Robert Tate, eds.	(Jones and Tate)
Three Editors	Jones, Susan, Bob Hart, and Chris Thomas, eds.	(Jones, Hart, and Thomas)
