\_\_\_\_\_ The **Lone Star College-CyFair (LSC-CyFair) Scholarship Program** offers scholarships to students who attend LSC-CyFair and/or LSC-Fairbanks Center. Scholarships are awarded in August for the Fall semester and in January for the Spring semester. \_\_\_\_\_ Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours at LSC-CyFair or LSC-Fairbanks Center for the semester in which applicant is applying, if you enroll in online classes make sure these belong to either LSC-CyFair or LSC-Fairbanks Center to meet the six credit hours requirement. If you plan to attend another LSC campus please complete the scholarship application for that specific campus, each campus has a different scholarship application and deadlines. Applicants must re-apply for LSC-CyFair scholarships every academic year. Applicants must have a Lone Star College cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher to be considered, (except for high school seniors as high school GPA will be used instead). If you are not a high school senior and have not taken classes at Lone Star College, this GPA may be acquired in the semester prior to scholarship awarding.

\_\_\_\_\_ Attach a transcript to this scholarship application if applicable, please follow these guidelines:

Current Lone Star College students: Do not attach a transcript.

High school seniors and recent high school graduates: Attach a current (unofficial) high school transcript.

\_\_\_\_\_ The (2) Reference Forms must be given to the two individuals you listed as references on your application. These individuals are to send the completed Reference Forms directly to the scholarship office at the address below. At least one of these references should be submitted by a teacher, instructor, counselor or administrator connected with the school you currently attend, or have been enrolled in during the past two years. For students who have not been enrolled in school for a period of one year or more, references should be from an employer, minister, supervisor, etc. Do not submit Reference Forms from family members. Explain to your references that all (4) sections of the reference form must be filled out completely.
