What is SAB?

What does SAB do?

All members coordinate programs that students want to see on campus. It takes lots of dedication and hard work, but we have fun doing it! In addition, members get experience working with vendors, performers, and the planning of major events like WelcomePalooza, and Fall Fest.

What's in it for me?

Besides the experience that you will receive in student leadership, SAB offers you opportunities such as:

Secretary – takes minutes (notes) at every meeting and keeps members up-to-date via email and other forms of communication

Treasurer – works with program manager with budgeting information

Student Government Representative – represents SAB in Student Government once a month meetings through-out the year

Historian - takes pictures for every event, and creates scrapbook at end of year

SAB Member – backbone of the group, set-up, run & breakdown events

What types of committees are there to join?

Fall Fest – October festival event with a Halloween theme, games, rides, and booths

Stress Relievers Week – week before finals events to help with those long study days

Spring Fling – Similar to Fall Fest except in the spring

Random Acts of Kindness – provide random acts of kindness throughout the semester

Entertainment – events ranging from comedians to musicians to video game days
