Activity Two:

4. If you scored a 85 or below on Test A, you need to repeat Activities One and Two from Week Two. Be sure to read four units that you have not read before. (If you scored more than 85 on Test A, you are completed with this unit of study.)
5. A session with the Writing tutor to discuss your work is strongly recommended.
6. When you have completed the four additional units, turn them in to the Reserve/Circulation Desk Assistant and request the Critical Reading Skills Test B. You will need your student i.d. to check out the test.
