- LSC Honors students admitted to SHSU will receive:
  - Acceptance to SHSU Honors College with a minimum GPA of 3.25 and satisfaction of other Honors College admission criteria such as, full-time enrollment of at least 12 hours.
  - SHSU will accept a maximum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credits
  - Honors students may be eligible for additional scholarships
  - If space permits, Honors students will be eligible to live in SHSU

### Optional Partnership

- Students jointly admitted to LSC and SHSU will receive:
  - Student ID at LSC and SHSU
  - Student computer/internet account at LSC and SHSU
  - Student access to computer labs and libraries at LSC and SHSU
  - Student access to sporting events at SHSU
  - Students will receive 3 unofficial transcripts at no cost. There will be a 3<sup>rd</sup> party fee for an official transcript.
  - LSC will have access to free electronic transcripts from SHSU, upon request from student for transmission of transcript.
- LSC students and employees admitted to SHSU will be allowed access to academic advising services at SHSU.

### Program Admission Requirements

- Student must have a cumulative 2.75 GPA; grade replacement is acceptable and student can retake classes at SHSU or LSC to replace grades (higher grade will replace lower grade). Students exceeding 30 hours over degree plan requirements (including retakes) will pay out-of-state tuition for the remainder of classes to complete degree. All attempted college hours are calculated, including withdrawals and initial attempts of a class.
