## **Welcome!**

## **Student Services**

In the Student Services Office, staff members provide support for both prospective and current students including assistance with application, admission, preliminary advising, financial aid, degree planning and class transfer. In the Student Services Office, we serve as your liaison to partner universities.

Current hours for the Student Services Office are: Monday - Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. and Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The Student Services Office at LSC-University Center at Montgomery is in

**Room 102** adjoining the lobby. The staff in the Student Services Office can meet with you on a walk-in basis during office hours or by appointment. We can also assist you as needed in contacting your academic advisor, financial aid advisor, registrar's office, etc. Partner university advisors plan visits to LSC-University Center at Montgomery through the Student Services Office to meet with students. Our goal is to assist you in contacting your home university without your traveling to that campus.

Student Services cannot accept work from students of face-to-face classes.

## Finding Your Way Around the Campus



The **Lobby** on the first floor is designed to be student-friendly! An afternoon/evening advisor will greet you, leisure-reading materials are

provided, and a “cyber café” with computers has been created. **Vending machines** can be found on the first and second floors: On the first floor between the elevator and the Commons, and on the second floor in the hallway behind the elevators. **The Commons area** is for your use as a place to eat, meet with other students, or just sit before and after class. It is located on the first floor behind the elevators. A **pay phone** is also located in this area.

A **suggestion box** is available to you at the main reception desk in the lobby. We welcome your comments as well as your concerns and needs. Students are welcome to use the quiet study room on the first floor, the library, or the computer lab in room 301. Please do not use empty classrooms.

**LSC-University Center at Montgomery** has joined other Texans and adopted a “**Smoke-Free Policy**.” Smoking and other tobacco products are prohibited on the campus proper. Smoking is restricted to the parking lots. Police officers have authority to enforce this new policy. **Join us in a healthy, smoke-free environment.**

### Third Floor

The **computer lab** (936.273.7385) is located at LSC-University Center at Montgomery in **Room 301** (beside the elevators). This facility is equipped with PCs for your use installed with current Microsoft Office applications including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access. The Internet is also available. Students may be able to connect to home university student applications and web-based e-mail accounts. Students at LSC-University Center at Montgomery are eligible for e-mail accounts through the Lone Star College System (LSCS). Please see a technology staff member to complete the application process for an e-mail address through LSCS.



**Library and academic support services** at LSC-University Center at Montgomery include a full-time librarian, a reserve desk, and a library located in **Room 300** (behind the elevators). This library has computer access to partner university electronic library catalogs and services, many databases, inter-library loan, and use of all college libraries in LSCS. The phone number for the library at LSC-University Center at Montgomery is 936.273.7562.

A copy machine is located on the third floor in the hallway behind the elevators. A “**copy card**” dispensing machine is located next to the copier. Please carefully read the instructions on both machines. The vendor charges \$1.00 to purchase a card with 50 cents value. Each copy is 10 cents. Value may be added to the card anytime.
