## Admission Requirements for the Teacher Preparation Program

- Completion of 44 hours of core requirements and those courses on the degree plan.
- Successfully pass all parts of one of the approved assessments : THEA, ASSET, COMPASS, or ACCUPLACER\*
- Minimum of 2.5 GPA, with grades of “C” or better
- Application to the Teacher Preparation Program.

The minimum total credit hours required for the Bachelor of Arts degree is 120.
