

# History

The History Department at the University of Houston offers a broad range of undergraduate courses in United States, Latin American and European History taught by nationally prominent faculty. In addition to our broad geographic coverage, the department has particular strengths in social history, ethnic studies, public history, legal history, family and gender, international business, military history, and the history of medicine.

A Bachelor of Arts in History is appropriate for students seeking a general liberal arts education as a preparation for careers in government, administration, business, education and law. It is also appropriate for students preparing for graduate studies in a variety of disciplines, including history and law.

In order to graduate, students must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours (36 hours must be advanced) with the last 30 hours from UH. A maximum of sixty-six hours may be transferred from a community college. Students may be eligible for an Associates degree from Lone Star College System after their first two years of study. Please see your Lone Star College advisor to check the requirements or refer to your LSC-Catalog pages 76-77.

The staff members in the Academic Student Services Office at the UC assist all students in determining which program of study to pursue. This includes providing information about the variety of programs available, reviewing transcripts to aid in identifying any courses to be completed before entering the program of choice, and serving as liaison between the student and university program representatives. Students who have already earned an associate's degree or have a substantial number of college academic credit hours should contact the Academic Student Services Office for advising and to begin the transfer admission process for the university offering the degree program they desire to pursue.
