

## Campus Impact

This is a short story of how I have impacted Lone Star College – Cy-Fair Campus. I started here Fall 2009 as a college student taking remedial classes. I also became involved with Campus Crusade for Christ Club. We were told that the previous two semesters the average attending club meetings were 3-5 college students. Then we took one day aside to feed our local Campus Police Officers with the coordinated effort of Captain Soliz. I have asked them to step up, and hand out bottles of water on campus every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday to other college students.
