Saving Work You've Done in **German Grammar Tutor**

When you are done with exercises assigned by your instructor in **German Grammar Tutor** & want to save your work, you must first name your progress file & save it to the appropriate place. When your work is saved as a *.txt file, *there is no need to print your score results*. A special place has been created on a networked drive for these student files.

Follow these simple instructions (*remember: **do not** click on "save" until the **very end!***):

- *In the lower right of the **German Grammar Tutor**, choose the **Quit** button. Once the screen opens choose **Save**.
- *Next, choose the drive onto which your file is to be stored by clicking on the down arrow in the **Save in:** field. Scroll down to the drive called **Lessons on Sony on 'Cfibr32-sony'**.
- *Choose the **German** folder by double-clicking on it.
- *Choose *your* instructor's folder (**Felusiak**, for example) by double-clicking on it.
- *Choose the **German Grammar Tutor Scores** folder by double-clicking on it.
- *Then, name your file. For example, name it with your first initial and last name (such as **jgoethe**). You can then add a number to the end of this file name for subsequent chapters (such as **jgoethe1**).
- *Click on **Save**, and you're done!
