To better serve all students and meet the educational needs of the diverse communities in the Houston area, the college has seven (7) campuses. All campuses offer **100 plus full degrees** and a complete English as a Second Language/English for Speakers of Other Languages (**ESL/ESOL**) program.

LSC offers robust student experiences through a variety of student organizations and events. International students may also be eligible to participate in our **nationally and globally recognized Honors College**, as well as **National Model United Nations** and **study abroad programs**—all of which include scholarship opportunities.

Opportunities after Graduation:

Graduates from Lone Star College earn an Associate's Degree while they transfer to other top colleges and universities thanks to articulation agreements developed with many major universities. Core class credits are guaranteed to transfer to public universities in the state of Texas. The college also has university centers on two of its campuses, in Houston and The Woodlands, where students can transfer to university partners to earn Bachelor's and Master's Degrees on site. Students are also eligible to apply for Post Completion Optional Practical Training (work authorization) through USCIS.
